

## **Holy Body and Blood of Christ**

This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**. In our Gospel reading, Jesus tells the Jewish crowds, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." Jesus' words are not understood by the crowd. How Jesus could give His flesh to eat was beyond their understanding and neither do they believe that Jesus is from heaven, being born of Mary and Joseph. Sensing their disbelief, Jesus continues, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink."

St. John further narrates in his Gospel that even when some disciples rejected this teaching and left, Jesus did not attempt to bring them back by saying that He was only speaking symbolically.

Jesus' teaching is very clear. Whoever eats His flesh and drinks His blood, will remain connected to Him. Jesus' words assure us of our intimate connection with Him through His Body and Blood. This is the mystery that is at the heart of our Eucharistic theology. Jesus' Body and Blood are truly present in the elements of bread and wine. When we receive the **Holy Body and Blood of Christ** in the Holy Eucharist, Jesus himself comes to dwell within us.

Today's celebration reminds us of Jesus' greatest gift of His Body and Blood ... not only though His death on the cross but also in the Holy Eucharist. When we hear "This is my Body ... this is my Blood" ... let us open our hearts to the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. May this challenge us to be transformed into what we receive and be the Christians Jesus wants us to be!

A happy and a blessed Solemnity of the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ** to all!

## Santo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo

Este domingo, celebramos la Solemnidad del **Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo**. En nuestra lectura del Evangelio, Jesús dice a las multitudes judías: "Yo soy el pan viviente que bajó del cielo; el que coma este pan vivirá para siempre; y el pan que daré es mi carne para la vida del mundo". Las palabras de Jesús no son entendidas por la multitud. Cómo Jesús pudo dar Su carne para comer, estaba más allá de su comprensión y tampoco creen que Jesús es del cielo, siendo nacido de María y José. Sintiendo su incredulidad, Jesús continuó: "Amén, amén, te digo, a menos que comas la carne del Hijo del Hombre y beban Su sangre, no tienes vida dentro de ti. El que coma mi carne y beba mi sangre tiene vida eterna, y yo lo criaré el último día. Porque mi carne es verdadera comida, y mi sangre es verdadera bebida".

San Juan narra además en su Evangelio que incluso cuando algunos discípulos rechazaron esta enseñanza y se fueron, Jesús no intentó traerlos de vuelta diciendo que solo estaba hablando simbólicamente.

La enseñanza de Jesús es muy clara. Quien coma Su carne y beba Su sangre, permanecerá conectado con Él. Las palabras de Jesús nos aseguran nuestra íntima conexión con Él a través de Su Cuerpo y Sangre. Este es el misterio que está en el corazón de nuestra teología eucarística. El Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús están realmente presentes en los elementos del pan y el vino. Cuando recibimos **el Santo Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo** en la Sagrada Eucaristía, Jesús mismo mora dentro de nosotros.

La celebración de hoy nos recuerda el mayor regalo de Jesús de Su Cuerpo y Sangre... no solo a través de Su muerte en la cruz, sino también en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Cuando escuchemos "Este es mi Cuerpo... Esta es mi Sangre"... Abramos nuestros corazones a la verdadera presencia de Jesús en la Eucaristía. ¡Que esto nos desafíe a transformarnos en lo que recibimos y ser los cristianos que Jesús quiere que seamos!

¡Una feliz y bendita Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo para todos!
