#### September 17, 2023- Twenty Fourth Sunday in the Ordinary Time Gospel reflection by Martha O'Brien Matthew 18:21-35

When Peter asks Jesus "Lord if my brother sins against me how often must I forgive?

As many as seven times?" Jesus answered, " I say to you not seven times but seventy-seven times."

He then shares the parable of how the kingdom of Heaven is likened to a king who decided to settle accounts with his servants. One of his debtors owes a huge debt he cannot repay. He falls down before the king pays him homage and says, "Be patient with me and I will pay you back in full." Moved with compassion, the master let him go and forgave him for the loan.

When I reflect on this parable, I see myself as that servant who owes a huge debt I can never repay.

The masters compassion comes through the crucifixion of our Lord where we receive His forgiveness and freedom from our sin.

What am I to do with this in my life?

I recognize I must forgive all who sin against me, offend me, and persecute me.

I am terrified to be found guilty of unforgiveness for this would mean I would not be forgiven.

The practice of forgiveness is not easy... But is always right.

Let us constantly ask our Lord to intercede for us in our relationships to work in our angry resentful hearts to break the chains that bind us to our resentments so that we may be free to surrender our hearts to Him.

### 17 de Septiembre de 2023- Vigesimo Cuarto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario Reflexión del Evangelio por Martha Obrien Mateo 18:21-35

Cuando Pedro le preguntó a Jesús "Señor, si mi hermano peca contra mí, ¿con qué frecuencia debo perdonar? ¿ hasta siete veces?" Jesús respondió: "Te digo no siete veces, sino setenta y siete veces".

Luego comparte la parábola de cómo se compara el reino de los Cielos con un rey que decidió liquidar cuentas con sus siervos. Uno de sus deudores tiene una enorme deuda que no puede pagar. Se cae ante el rey que le rinde homenaje y dice: "Ten paciencia conmigo y te lo devolveré en su totalidad". Movido con compasión, el maestro lo dejó ir y le perdonó el préstamo.

Cuando reflexiono sobre esta parábola, me veo a mí mismo como ese sirviente que tiene una enorme deuda que nunca puedo pagar.

La compasión de los maestros viene a través de la crucifixión de nuestro Señor, donde recibimos su perdón y libertad de nuestro pecado.

¿Qué voy a hacer con esto en mi vida?

Reconozco que debo perdonar a todos los que pecan contra mí, ofenderme y perseguirme.

Estoy aterrorizado de que me declaren culpable de falta de perdón porque esto significa que no sería perdonado.

La práctica del perdón no es fácil... Pero siempre es correcta.

Pidamos constantemente a nuestro Señor que interceda por nosotros en nuestras relaciones para trabajar en nuestros corazones enojados y resentidos para así romper las cadenas que nos unen a nuestros resentimientos para que podamos ser libres de entregar nuestros corazones a Él.
