Dear Parishioners,

Blessings and Peace!

A New Year is upon us! May this first month of the year inspire us all to look back to the past year with gratitude and to welcome the New Year with hope and enthusiasm.

Two Decembers ago, my 2022 ended with the receipt of a "Letter of Assignment" from Bishop Vasa appointing me as Parochial Administrator of the Saint Joseph Parish in Middletown and its Missions. With great hope, I then looked forward to how 2023 would be ... not only for me but more importantly, for the Parish. It is hard to believe that 2023 is over. Things went so fast that I now find myself looking back to it as the past year ... and I am doing so with heartfelt gratitude!

The kindness and welcome that I received from all of you were heartwarming. Your overwhelming support and generosity enabled us to accomplish so many things in so little time. There is no doubt in my mind that you are all instruments of God's approval and intervention for the provision of our needs and completion of our projects. Indeed, God's hand was at work amidst us! Eternally thankful to God and to you all for a productive and a blessed 2023!

As we embark on this New Year of 2024, I am again filled with great hope that God will continue to guide and help us accomplish even greater things in our Parish. We started with a very encouraging news, expressing extreme joy from our Diocese, that our Parish was one of 28 parishes out of 42 that met or exceeded the Annual Ministry Appeal (AMA) for the year 2023. As such, our Parish received a rebate of \$1,339. While our 2023 goal was \$12,480, this year, it is \$12,500. With God's grace and with your full support, I am confident that we will again meet, if not exceed, our AMA goal for 2024. For that, I thank you all in advance!

Last year, I announced that our Church building and the rectory are in dire need of new roofs considering that these have not been replaced for the last 30 or so years. During this rainy season, the roofs have deteriorated even further. Two roofing companies estimate the total cost to be \$40,000. Thus, for this year and perhaps till the next year, we will be having fund raising activities for the roofing project.

Once again, allow me to express this urgent appeal for your full support of this project. This appeal goes not only to you as individuals but also to your families, friends and neighbors ... and to the various organizations in our Parish to assist in our fund raising. To facilitate the tracking of funds raised and subsequent expenditures, we will be opening a separate account for the roofing project.
