

First reading

Reading Genesis 3:8-15 this reading tells us about being alert to the rift of the enemy, because he always wants to envelop us with his cunning and lies to make us sin.

God gives us the confidence and the freedom to choose between good and bad, but we always must be alert and not fall into the sin that surrounds us every day. God's mercy is infinite, and we have to be in his way, look for him and obey him always so as not to fall into the traps of the evil one.

Second reading.

Corinthians 4:14-5: in this reading God shows us that we are passing through this world and just as God our Lord resurrected his son, he will also raise us one day as long as we have to face any tribulation. Our glory will be in the eternal house of God that heaven will give us.

Gospel / St. Mark 3: 20-35
