The Gospel of Saint Mark tells us about the Kingdom of God, which is like a seed that we must plant in our hearts. God gives that seed to each of us, so that with a lot of faith and love, we can take care of it and make it grow.

We cannot forget about the bad seed, which doesn't need to be cultivated to produce bad fruits on its own. This refers to negative feelings, such as: evil, envy, hatred, lies, corruption, and selfishness. They are feelings that do not need care to grow. They are like a plague, when it enters your heart, it is difficult to tear out.

If you realize that there is a feeling that is not compatible with the Kingdom of God, get it out of your heart. Sooner or later, it can not only hurt you, but it can also hurt the people around you. Take care of the seed that God has given you, feed it, cultivate it with great love so that it grows and bears fruit. Jesus gave us the seed, in his Word, in faith, in love, in the knowledge of God and in the Sacraments. Let us make the Kingdom of God present in our daily living, with good works and actions, so that we can enjoy and delight in what is and will be, one day the Kingdom of God. Reflect and ask yourself:

How am I taking care of the seed that God has given me?

What am I doing in order for it to grow in me and in others?
