Newsletter - June 2024

Dear Parishioners,

We opened this month of June with the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). On Corpus Christi Sunday in 2022, a 3-year National Eucharistic Revival was launched to inspire a "renewed encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist!" We may not be able to join the on-going National Eucharistic Procession nor have our own, but we did our share of reflecting, venerating and honoring the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist during our day-long adoration last June 2. My heartfelt thanks to those who kept vigil in prayer during the adoration!

This month, we also celebrated the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the Solemnity of the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist.

As I reported last month, the roof repairs for the Church, the classroom building and the rectory are complete and I am truly grateful to all who donated and contributed to the project completion. However, we cannot declare the project closed as full funding has yet to be settled. The current roofing project balance is \$28,337. Any additional donation will be greatly appreciated and please make checks out to St. Joseph Roofing Fund.

I am equally grateful to those who have donated to our Annual Ministry Appeal (AMA). The total donation so far is \$11,677 which is \$823 short of our goal of \$12,500. Am appealing for your generosity to help meet our goal.

Thank you very much to all who bought tickets and supported our "Saint Joseph Banquet" at Twin Pines. Thanks, too, to all who donated auction items, about a hundred for silent auction and 12 for live auction. My gratitude also goes to Peter Ventura, our live auctioneer.

As of this writing, the event is yet to happen but based on what I have observed of your overwhelming support and generosity, I am confident that our "Saint Joseph Banquet" will be a great success! With God's grace, may this great success translate to the raising of enough funds to cover this year's insurance premiums for the three Churches and the rectory!

My heartfelt thanks to our fundraising committee chairperson Jane Cauley and all members of the committee for organizing the event! And my special thanks, too, to Pat and Lisa Lambert who will be hosting the "Feast with the Priest" raffle winners at their lovely home. Thanks to all who bought raffle tickets ... the two winners to be announced when it happens!

As our Parish continues to grow, I would like to thank our new Committee of Hospitality members: Margaret Carlisle, Thomas Scalfaro, Mike Tomko and Zoi Bracisco.

This is to remind you all that the enrollment for first communion and confirmation classes will be from July 3 to August 31. Please encourage your children and grandchildren to enroll for the classes. Also, if you know anyone among your friends and relatives who is interested in becoming a Catholic or in need of adult confirmation, please contact Roger Mattu or call the office for registration.
