

Spiritual Reflection 20th Sunday of Ordinary Time

The Importance of Believing and Salvation by Zoi Brasico

In today's Gospel Reading (John 6:51 - 58), Jesus continues to teach the crowd and us, too, on the need to eat His flesh and drink His blood to gain Eternal Life. We also see the crowd who continue to question and who obviously cannot understand what Jesus is teaching them.

In response to the people who quarreled over Jesus' words, He teaches them with even greater emphasis and says, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day."

Indeed, it was difficult for the crowd then to understand what Jesus was teaching them ... perhaps because this reality could only be understood after Jesus passion, death and resurrection.

With the benefit of hindsight ... and now knowing the events that took place from Jesus' Last Supper to His passion, death and resurrection, we cannot be like the unbelieving crowd! We cannot be like some people today who continue to struggle to accept Jesus' Words to eat His Body and drink His Blood!

And yes, believing in Jesus' Words is very important as they are key to our salvation.

Let us all thank God for the Living Bread that came down from Heaven ... the Eternal Life-giving Bread, that is the Holy Eucharist ... that we receive in every Eucharistic Celebration we attend!

La Importancia de Creer en la Salvación Por Zoi Brasico

En la lectura del Evangelio de hoy (Juan 6:51 - 58), Jesús continúa enseñando a la multitud y a nosotros también sobre la necesidad de comer Su carne y beber Su sangre para obtener la Vida Eterna. También vemos a la multitud que continúa cuestionando, y que obviamente no puede entender lo que Jesús les está enseñando.

En respuesta a las personas que se pelearon por las palabras de Jesús, Él las enseña con un énfasis aún mayor y dice: "Amén, amén, te digo, a menos que coman la carne del Hijo del Hombre y beban su sangre, no tiene vida dentro de ti. Quien coma mi carne y beba mi sangre tendrá vida eterna, y yo lo levantaré el último día".

De hecho, era difícil para la multitud entender lo que Jesús les estaba enseñando... tal vez porque esta realidad solo se podía entender después de la pasión, la muerte y la resurrección de Jesús.

Con el beneficio de la retrospectiva... y ahora conociendo los acontecimientos que tuvieron lugar desde la Última Cena de Jesús hasta Su pasión, muerte y resurrección, ¡no podemos ser como la multitud incrédula! ¡No podemos ser como algunas personas hoy en día que continúan luchando por aceptar las Palabras de Jesús para comer Su Cuerpo y beber Su Sangre!

Y sí, creer en las Palabras de Jesús es muy importante, ya que son clave para nuestra salvación. Todos demos gracias a Dios por el Pan Vivo que vino del Cielo... el Pan Eterno que da la Vida, que es la Santa Eucaristía... ¡que recibimos en cada Celebración Eucarística a la que asistimos!
