Dear Parishioners,

Blessings and Peace!

As we all know, the 2025 Jubilee Year officially opened on Christmas Eve of 2024 with the rite of the Opening of the Holy Door at the Basilica of St. Peter by Pope Francis. With the theme of "Pilgrims of Hope" ... this is a great opportunity for us all to receive indulgences to make this Jubilee Year fruitful and meaningful by fulfilling the conditions necessary for the graces of indulgences!

Last month, I shared with you my official acceptance as a member of the clergy of the Diocese of Santa Rosa but I failed to mention that it came with my appointment as Pastor of St. Joseph Parish in Middletown for a six-year period, ending October 31, 2030. Yes, my appointment ends in October as the official acceptance and appointment letter was actually signed on October 31, 2024!

With great hope rooted on this Jubilee Year and the years to come, let us together create and build a well-founded Catholic culture to further strengthen and enliven our spiritual lives and enflame the torch of faith in our Parish families and communities. The change of my status in the Diocese of Santa Rosa necessitates my return to the Philippines for visa requirements. By the time you read this Newsletter, I shall have left as my appointment at the US Embassy in the Philippines is January 16, 2024. God is good, indeed, as this is an opportune time for me to be home for the 80th birthday of my mother on January 21!

On behalf of our Diocese, I am reminding you all of the Annual Ministry Appeal (AMA). Last year, we failed to achieve our AMA goal of \$12,500.00 by \$28.00 as the Diocese received only \$12,472.00 from the pledged amount of \$13,222.00! Consequently, our Parish did not receive any rebate. This year, our goal is \$11,900.00. Please support our Annual Ministry Appeal and let us aim for a rebate this year!

Also, we do need to raise funds for the payment of the premiums of the insurances of our three Churches. Please support the super bowl squares, the bake sale and our annual Saint Joseph Banquet for our insurance purposes. Thank you in advance for your generosity!
