Dear Parishioners,

Lenten Blessings! "We adore you, O Christ and we praise you, for by your Holy Cross you have redeemed the world!" But through the intercession of St. Joseph and your generosity, we do manage to pull through with the fund raising. As always, the St. Joseph Annual Banquet Fundraiser was a great success! My special thanks to all for your unwavering support. Special thanks, too, to Toni Vecellio and Margaret Carlisle for organizing and sponsoring the Feast with the Priest which this year will be catered by Matt Medcalf, former Chef of Greenview Bar and Grill at Hidden Valley.

Third, repairs at Our Lady of the Lake Church are progressing encouragingly. The doors have been installed. We paid about \$1,500 for the doors but we have yet to be billed for the gutters. For the Church's new heating and cooling unit, we had five bidders. Our Finance Council then the Chancery approved the bid from Jonas Heating and Cooling in the amount of \$12,875. Once again, I am appealing to your generosity for any financial assistance you can extend for the installation of the new heating and cooling unit. In addition, please support the Bake Sale on Easter Sunday that will be spearheaded by Our Lady of the Lake Guild. Funds raised at the Bake Sale will also go to the said project.
